# AT THE SHARP END



Please make your own way to Liverpool and to the Atlantic Tower Thistle Hotel on Monday.

You are booked into the Hotel for two nights Bed & Breakfast on the Monday and Tuesday of your course.

On Tuesday you will be collected from reception at 9am and escorted to the Brookes Bell office which is nearby. From then on your food and transport will all be arranged by Brookes Bell.

**Ship visits can be quite arduous with many steps to climb – some vertical. Therefore it is not suitable for anybody with breathing or walking difficulties.**

**You will need sensible warm clothing suitable for ship visits, and a lightweight waterproof jacket. You should be aware that your clothes may get slightly dirty.**

**We will provide safety footwear, hi-vis waistcoats and helmets which must be worn and boiler suits (which are recommended but optional). You should bring personal identification; either a current passport or UK photo driving licence. No other forms of ID are acceptable to the port authorities.**

The course will finish at 4.45pm on Wednesday, therefore all return travel should be booked for 5.15pm onwards.

A full itinerary and details of the course delegates will be sent to you or provided at the hotel on your arrival, but the programme and content may change at short notice depending on shipping schedules, tidal conditions, etc.

The course is accredited by The Law Society for at least 12 hours CPD, depending on the programme.

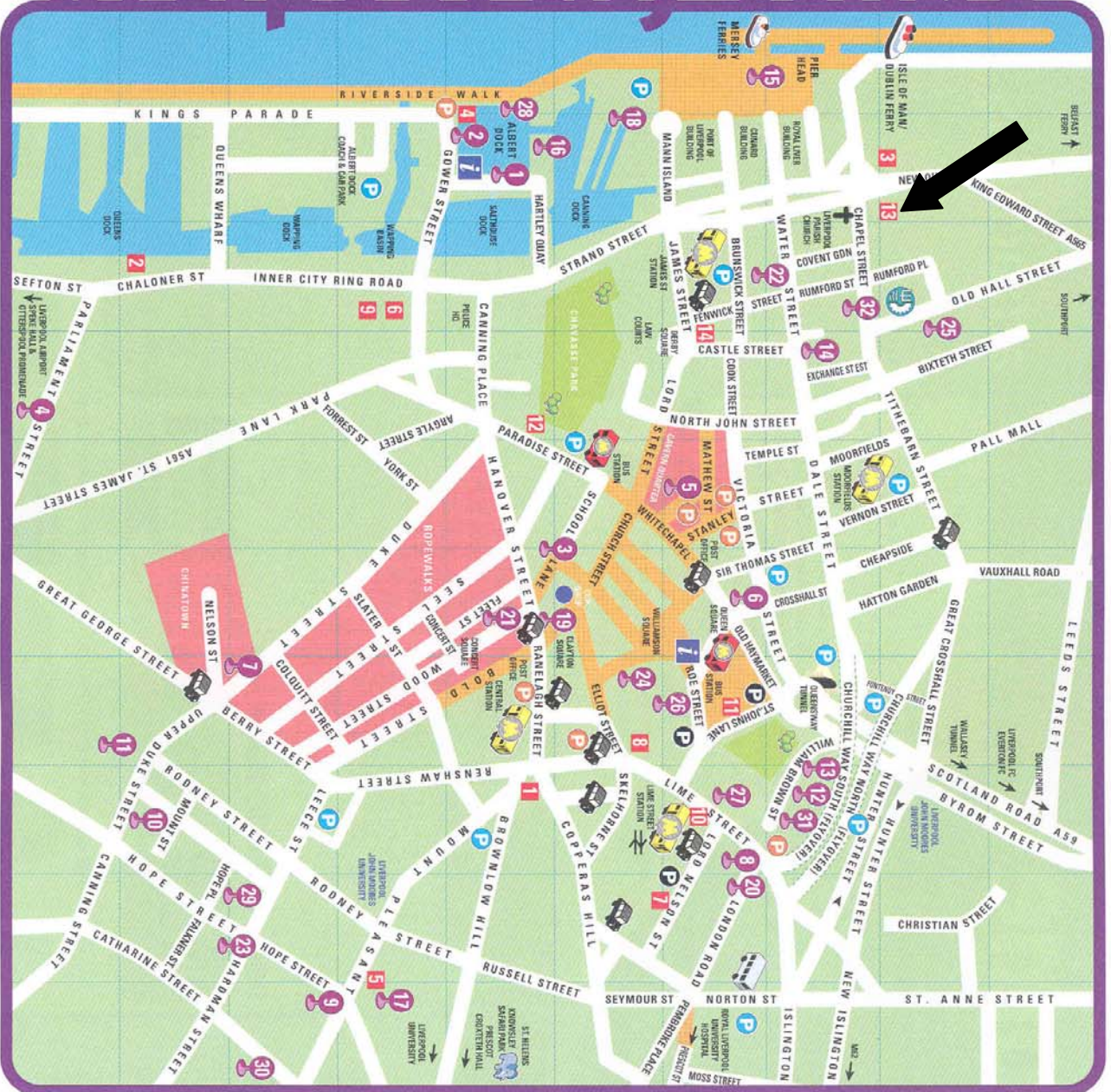
