Has a wealth of experience in Marine/Cargo Operations, Safety, Navigation and Seamanship. Captain Dean brings with him over 40 years of experience in deck officer roles on board a wide range of general cargo ships, bulk carriers and chemical tankers, including seven (7) years as Master in the Stolt Tanker fleet.

For ten (10) years, he was Operations Manager for Stolt Tankers, and in 2005 the Stolthaven Marine Terminal, in New Orleans responsible for all cargo operations, including barge trans-shipments, in the Mississippi River, Alabama, Mississippi and Florida gulf ports. In August 2005, Captain Dean managed the hurricane readiness process at the marine terminal in advance of Hurricane Katrina and planned the initial response afterwards. He was "Deputized" by the Plaquemines Parish Sheriff's department as part of the "Disaster Relief Team".

For twelve (12) years he was The Director of Global Operations for Stolt Tankers B.V. which responsibilities included managing and approval of policies and procedures for the global fleets; attending and presenting at bi-annual Safety Training Conferences of company seafarers of many nationalities; Masters, officers and crew. He managed the fuel purchasing process for the deep-sea fleet and operations at the Stolt US barge fleet and cleaning depot in Houston.

Captain Dean has extensive experience in tank cleaning, preparation for loading and carriage of the entire range of liquid cargo products, including heated and cooled products, Propylene Oxide, Phenol, Isocyanates, Caprolactum, and Coconut and Palm oils. In 2000 and 2001, Captain Dean assisted at local and state government levels to identify the site, participate in the waterfront property purchase negotiations from the Norfolk Southern Railroad and obtain the requisite permits and approvals from the various State Departments for the establishment of Stolthaven Terminal in Braithwaite, Louisiana. Captain Dean's contribution included working closely with the River Pilot Associations and personal meetings with the Governor of Louisiana, Mike Foster, and Attorney General to obtain their cooperation which cleared the path for the project to commence.

In 2012, Captain Dean was part of the emergency team which lead the handling of safe trans-shipment of hazardous cargo and salvage of a chemical tanker which had sustained major damage following an explosion on board whilst transiting in the Arabian Gulf.
